Re: Implementation of Ottawa's Smoke-Free Outdoor Bylaw

Dear Chair Holmes and Members of the Ottawa Board of Health:

We are writing on behalf of the Ottawa Council on Smoking or Health (OCSH) to report on the first summer of smoke-free outdoor spaces in Ottawa. We wish to commend the Ottawa Board of Health for initiating a plan for smoke-free outdoor spaces. The smoke-free outdoor bylaw, enacted by Ottawa City Council in February 2012, has since become a role model for other municipalities in Ontario and will lead to a healthier Ottawa.

The OCSH has received positive feedback about the smoke-free outdoor bylaw. The general sentiment is that the bylaw is a success. OCSH members reported that they shopped more frequently at the Byward and Parkdale Markets and they enjoyed restaurant patios because of the smoke-free status. OCSH members noticed a very high compliance rate on restaurant patios, and at city parks, playgrounds and sports fields.

The OCSH is a local volunteer organization established in 1978. We work to create a social environment where non-smoking is the norm; to assist in establishing smoke-free environments; to prevent youth from starting to smoke; to encourage smokers to quit; and to advocate for better smoking cessation resources.

The smoke-free outdoor bylaw is common sense legislation. It is already improving the health of Ottawa's residents. We thank you again for supporting this important public health initiative.
